**Re: Request under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act***

British Columbia Ferry Services Inc. (BC Ferries) received your request for access to records under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the FOIPP Act) on August 31, 2015. Your request was as follows:

*"I make this request pursuant to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy for all records, memos, letters, and emails from the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure, BC Ferries and CH2M Hill Canada Limited in regards to the Gabriola bridge feasibility study. The time frame for this request is December 1, 2014 to August 30th, 2015."*

Further to our letter of October 7, 2015, you will recall we sent consultations to a public body and a third party. Enclosed please find copies of the public body's records responsive to your request. As noted in our letter of November 19, 2015, the third party has until December 17, 2015 to apply for a review and we will respond separately regarding their records.

Some of the enclosed records contain information excepted from disclosure under the FOIPP Act. This information was severed so the remaining information could be disclosed. We have removed personal information under section 22 of the FOIPP Act, as its disclosure would be an unreasonable invasion of third parties' privacy. An excerpt of the relevant section is attached.

In addition, we have removed information which was also sent in our consultation with the third party. This information will be included in our response for the third party records as noted above.

We have noted on the records disclosed to you the information which was redacted.
