EMERGENCY SIGNALS
INITIAL RESPONSE PARTY - VERBAL ORDER BY P/A, RADIO AND ALL AVAILABLE MEANS - "RESPONSE PARTY TO SCENE" (MEDICAL EMERGENCY - "ORA TO SCENE")
EMERGENCY / FIRE STATIONS - LONG RING ON THE GENERAL ALARM
PREPARE EVACUATION STATIONS - SEVEN (7) SHORT OR MORE FOLLOWED BY ONE (1) PROLONGED RING ON THE GENERAL ALARM
DEPLOY EVACUATION SYSTEMS - VERBAL ORDER BY LEAD OPERATOR (P/A OR RADIO) - "DEPLOY, DEPLOY, DEPLOY"
ABANDON SHIP - VERBAL ORDER BY LEAD OPERATOR (P/A OR RADIO) - "ABANDON SHIP, ABANDON SHIP, ABANDON SHIP"
EMERGENCY BOAT STATIONS - THREE (3) PROLONGED BLASTS ON THE SHIPS WHISTLE, FOLLOWED BY A P/A ANNOUNCEMENT
EMERGENCY WARNING - TEN (10) OR MORE SHORT BLASTS BY ALL AVAILABLE MEANS, FOLLOWED BY A P/A ANNOUNCEMENT
Notes
CLASS: Sheltered Waters
Department heads shall ensure that all duties are covered.
If Supervisor is unable to perform their assigned duties, subordinates within their department should move up one level and assume those duties.
FIRE - Fire discovered: Raise Alarm, Clear the area, Make 1 Attempt to Extinguish, Contain the Fire, Contact Control Station, act according to duties.
SWEEPING DUTIES - In a scenario where the 1st emergency signal heard is "Prepare Evacuation Stations", crews assigned to sweeping duties during "Emergency/Fire Stations" shall do so prior to going to their muster station.
PASSENGERS - On hearing the "Prepare Evacuation Stations" or the "Fire/Emergency Stations" signal - Proceed immediately to the Assembly Station.
